- Projects list is the people going after the funds; they don't open RCAP every year
- Ex: remodeling HAAC building downtown; got into the RCAP bill, but it could take 6-7 years for decision to use those funds; when RCAP opens, they submit app to be awarded the funds
- PFF asking for a little over 1 mil for a new barn
